■ Once you have determined your Fitzpatrick level, the next step is to find out if you are a cool, neutral or warm skin tone. The following information will help you find your tonal family. Neutral shades typically work on all skin tones.

Cool	Warm
Look best in "jewel tones" - blues, greens, pinks, purples, blue-greens, magentas, and blue-based reds.	Shine in "earth tones" - yellows, oranges, browns, yellowish greens and orange-based reds.
Look better in pure white than ivory.	Look better in ivory than pure white.
Can easily wear black.	Look washed out with black worn close to the face.
