PROCEDURE FOR A MINI MANICURE

- 1. Prepare table
 - disinfect tabletop
 - towel and cushion on table
 - > arrange table
- 2. Seat client
- 3. WASH HANDS
- 4. Remove old nail polish
 - > hold on for a few seconds then draw forward
- 5. Shape nails
 - discuss nail shape
 - > use rough side of emery board
 - > file from corner to center
- 6. Soak hand to soften cuticle
- 7. Dry fingertips
- 8. Apply cuticle remover
- 9. Loosen cuticle
 - > use orangewood stick covered with cotton
- 10. Apply cuticle oil to the cuticle, work into cuticle (repeat steps 7 11 on right hand)
- Rinse oil off nails
- Dry finger tips well

COMPLETION STEPS

- Bevel the nails (fine side of emery board)
- Clean under free edge (using a metal file)
- Buff nails
- apply base coat
- apply liquid polish (2 coats)
- remove excess polish
- apply top
- clean up (sanitize all manicure implements)

- Towels for table
- ➤ Nail Polish Remover, Implements, Supplies
- Nail Polish
- > Implements: Orange wood stick, emery

Reminders:

- ➤ Loosen lids of bottles before starting.
- Always begin with left hand and work from little finger to thumb, then do right hand little finger to thumb.
- Soak left hand while shaping right hand.
